

PSEG LONG ISLAND HOME COMFORT AND HOME PERFORMANCE PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT

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RE: 2025 Home Comfort and Home Performance Program and Application Version 1.0 Release

PSEG Long Island is pleased to announce the 2025 Home Comfort & Home Performance Program V1.0 application workbook. This workbook is effective January 1, 2025. Please note that projects (sold in 2024) must be submitted by COB of December 31, 2024 with the 2024 application and under 2024 requirements. All applications submitted on/after January 1, 2025 must use the 2025 application and subjected to the 2025 program requirements.

Changes to the Home Comfort Program 2025 (effective January 1, 2025) include:

- Freeze stats are NO longer an eligible measure for 2025 rebate for controlling existing fossil fuel systems.
 - Therefore, either remove fossil fuel heating system, or
 - Install dual fuel thermostat/integrated controls (with heat pump as primary heating and fossil fuel system as secondary heating)
 - There is no rebate for the required dual fuel thermostat/integrated controls.
- There are higher rebates for Disadvantaged Communities. These rebates are capped at \$6,250/project. PSEG Long Island will make the final determination if a customer is located within a Disadvantaged Community based on the following link and data. https://www.nyserda.ny.gov/ny/disadvantaged-communities

^{*}For the purpose of this table, "Tons" is referring to Heating BTUh based on AHRI 17f Rated data (ccASHP) or Heating Capacity (AWHP)

- Workbook requires the condition of the existing heating and cooling equipment to be noted "End of Life",
 "Early Retirement" or "New".
- Tankless water heaters rebates have been discontinued.

^{**}Rebates are based on Total Heating Capacity



- Heat Pump Water Heater rebate is now \$1,200/unit (for Market Rate and Disadvantaged-Communities) and \$1,700/unit (for Low Moderate Income). The contractor incentive is now \$100/project.
- Tune Ups rebates have been discontinued
- Equipment Only Rebate (\$250/heat pump) have been discontinued

Also ground source heat pump rebates are now \$1,500/heating ton (market) and \$3,000/heating ton (low-moderate income) for new installation. For retrofit, the ground source heat pump rebates are now \$500/heating ton (market) and \$1,000/heating ton (low-moderate income).
