Partner Programs

Electric Vehicle Make Ready Partner

PSEG Long Island's Electric Vehicle (EV) Make Ready program offers incentives for the infrastructure needed to power Level 2 and DCFC across Long Island. This program is available for all commercial customers including Multi-Unit Dwellings, Retail/Offices, Parking Facilities/Lots, and more.

Fleet Make Ready Partner

PSEG Long Island's Fleet Make Ready program supports the development of EV charging infrastructure for public fleet and public transportation fleets. This includes light duty, medium duty, and heavy-duty vehicle segments design services.

Terms and Conditions

The Partner shall observe the following to retain a good relationship with PSEG Long Island:

- The Partner shall accurately represent the relationship between the Partner and PSEG Long Island as follows - The Partner is an independent contractor, and a participant in PSEG Long Island Transportation Electrification Programs. Participating Partners shall not represent themselves as working for, approved by, or certified by PSEG Long Island.
- The Partner shall maintain all relevant licenses required by federal, state, county or municipal governments or any other agencies with jurisdiction over work they performed under PSEG Long Island.
- The Partner shall provide customers with informational materials as required by PSEG Long Island.
- If a Partner becomes involved in a dispute with a customer over business practices, the Partner shall work with PSEG Long Island to resolve the dispute amicably. In any event, the Partner shall hold PSEG Long Island harmless from any suit arising from work performed under PSEG Long Island Transportation Electrification Programs.
- The Partner must disclose whether any individual(s) including owners, principles, shareholders, associates, and employees affiliated with the Partner have previously participated in, or are currently participating in, any of PSEG Long Island's programs. If so, list all individuals on the Application, as this is an ongoing requirement.
- The Partner acknowledges that participation in PSEG Long Island's Transportation Electrification

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Programs is a privilege, and that PSEG Long Island may suspend or terminate Partner’s participation in PSEG Long Island’s Transportation Electrification Programs for any reason, including failure to maintain program standards, or if valid complaints are made against the Partner’s business. In all cases involving a Partner’s participation status, PSEG Long Island’s written decision is final.

- PSEG Long Island reserves the right to make changes to program requirements and incentives. Partners will receive notice of such changes. Notification shall be by email and posting on <https://www.psegliny.com>
- The Partner shall continue to complete at least 3 projects with PSEG Long Island in a 12 month rolling period to remain an active Program Partner

Captures Partner Portal Access (*Optional*)

The Partner Portal allows users to submit applications directly to Captures, which is the database used to track and monitor applications for both Make-Ready programs. You will be able to submit applications through this portal, along with being able to check on the status of each, and receive direct feedback from the Transportation Electrification team.

Partner Portal Users are limited to 2 per company. One user must be the Principal of the business who has signature authority. The other should be the user identified by the Principal. It is the Lead Partner’s responsibility to notify PSEG Long Island when a user’s access should be changed or revoked. Please fill out the information below.
